FROM OUR YOUTH PASTOR

I have been reading through the Book of Revelation lately, and I am beginning to understand more each time I go through it. I did not hear most of Pastor's series through Revelation on Sunday nights because I would take the kids out after the object lesson. Pastor may have already mentioned this. One great blessing about the events that transpire in most of the book does not effect us. In Revelation 14:19-20, we get a small glimpse of what transpires at the end of the Battle of Armageddon. 19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. 20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and 1,600 furlongs." This verse tells us how far the blood of those who die will stretch. One furlong is roughly 660 ft. If you multiply that by 600, you get a length of 1,056,000 ft. Divide that number by 5,280 to get the mileage. You will end up with 200 miles! To put this into perspective, the Florida Georgia state line is 216 miles north of us down I75! That takes about three hours to drive. That is a lot of blood! Now, there is more to it. The verses tell us that the blood will reach up to the horses bridle in depth, so that means it could be as deep as 4.5 feet. That is even more astonishing! There will be a lot of people who will perish before Jesus Christ because of their rebellious hearts. Many horses will die along with them. What a blessing it is to the saints who will be with Christ when He conquers His enemies! That will be you and me! It makes me think of that song, "Once I drifted out in sin, had no hope nor joy within, / And my soul was burdened down with pride: / Then my Savior came along and he showed me I was wrong and /Now I know I'm on the winning side / I'm on the winning side, yes I'm on the winning side, / Out in sin no more will I abide, / I've enlisted in the fight or the cause of truth and right / Praise the Lord- I'm on the winning side."
